To encourage better participation in our tournaments and events, Lake Creek's members will be playing for a trophy similar to the professional tour. Points will be awarded to all of those entering leagues and tournaments. Bonus points will be awarded to those who finish in the top five in each flight (1st in the 3rd flight is awarded the same number of points as the overall champion). Points will double for the four declared Lake Creek major tournaments (19-man, Club Championship, Member-Guest, and ABCD). The 2019 season will end with the ABCD Tournament on Labor Day. There will be a year end banquet to announce the winner along with the Top 10 finishers on Saturday September 7th. The winner of the Security Bank Cup will be given a Grand Prize and the Top 10 will be entered into a drawing for a golf getaway at a destination to be named.

THE POINTS WILL BE AWARDED AS FOLLOWS:

ENTERED:	25 POINTS
1ST PLACE (EACH FLIGHT):.....	50 BONUS POINTS
2ND PLACE (EACH FLIGHT):.....	40 BONUS POINTS
3RD PLACE (EACH FLIGHT):.....	30 BONUS POINTS
4TH PLACE (EACH FLIGHT):.....	20 BONUS POINTS
5TH PLACE (EACH FLIGHT):.....	10 BONUS POINTS

LAKE CREEK MAJOR TOURNAMENTS

ENTERED:	50 POINTS
1ST PLACE (EACH FLIGHT):.....	100 POINTS
2ND PLACE (EACH FLIGHT):.....	80 POINTS
3RD PLACE (EACH FLIGHT):.....	60 POINTS
4TH PLACE (EACH FLIGHT):.....	40 POINTS
5TH PLACE (EACH FLIGHT):.....	20 POINTS

10 bonus points are also awarded for shooting a round below your handicap. The round must be 18 holes and played with a witness assuming the rules of golf were followed.

The Lake Creek tournament committee believes participation in numerous events should be rewarded. The point system should reward the golfer who plays in the most events, as opposed to the best golfer. The major tournaments were designated based on which tournaments Lake Creek wanted to highlight.

Lake Creek will hold events after Labor Day (3-man die-hard, the late season league, and others to be announced), the points accumulated will carry over into the 2020 season (much like the PGA tour).
